Have you ever walked through a coffee forest 1700 meters above sea level? Our coffee will take you to the geography of Cundinamarca which will overpower all your senses. *Explore the aroma, fragrance, taste and body of our four arabic varieties*. *Taste the magic!*

Get to know us:

Our coffee is grown at high altitudes, in the eastern Colombian Andes (**The land of Coffee**), at an average altitude of 1,700 meters above sea level, under optimal conditions for the development of high-quality coffee with complex and memorable flavors. We harvest and process our grains carefully; nurturing, collecting and selecting by hand only the ripe grains of each harvest so that only these delicious beans reach our customers. Our commitment is with the highest standards of coffee production.

We cultivate under a regenerative agriculture and agroforestry approach and use monitoring technology, a field laboratory and a new ecological mill specially designed to take care of the quality of the grain in every step of the process and significantly reduce the amount of water needed.

We manage a plantation of about 27,000 coffee plants comprised of four different arabica coffee varieties: Tabi (22.63%), Castillo Santa Bárbara (52.12%), Cenicafé1/Cn1 (23.86%) and Geisha (1.39%)*

*We plan to plant 700 new Geisha plants by the end of 2023

In the last five years we have focused on bringing our coffee to a higher quality. As a result of this effort, we have received the following certifications and awards:
